

What Road am I Traveling On? Roadway Jurisdiction Responsibility in Marion County

On any given day, residents and visitors of Marion County travel many roadways to and from their destinations. Despite a network of connections to our communities and places, roadways are the responsibility of several government jurisdictions.

State Roadways

Responsibility of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT)

State roadways in Marion County include I, U.S. and State Roads. State roadways are identified with both their official designation shield sign and local name, such as State Road 200/SW College Road, State Road 40/Silver Springs Boulevard and U.S. 301/441 Pine Avenue. These roads, despite dual names, are the responsibility of FDOT for maintenance, improvements and receiving public feedback.

Local Roadways

Responsibility of Marion County, City of Belleview, City of Dunnellon, City of Ocala

Local roadways in Marion County are generally identified with a standard street sign and maintained by the jurisdiction within their respective boundary. Some local roadways traverse multiple boundaries and may be the responsibility of more than one jurisdiction. Roadways signed with County Road shields are the responsibility of Marion County. Public feedback on local roadways should be directed to the four respective jurisdictions.
